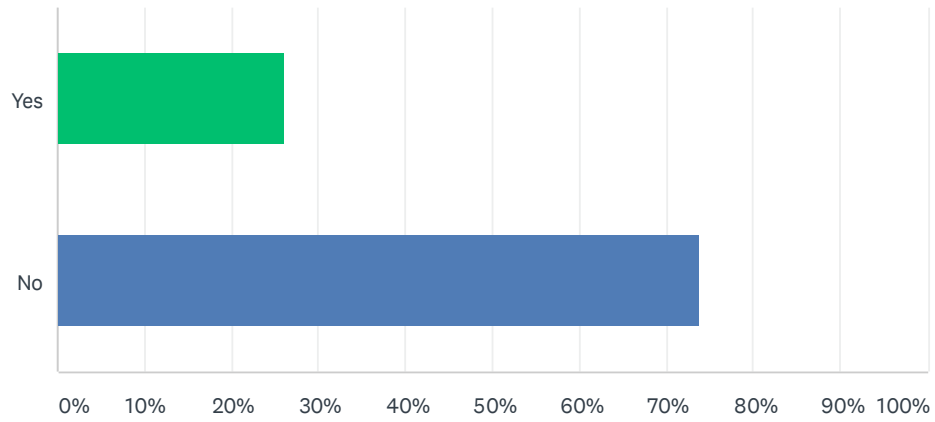


Q1 Have you already voted in the 2020 election?

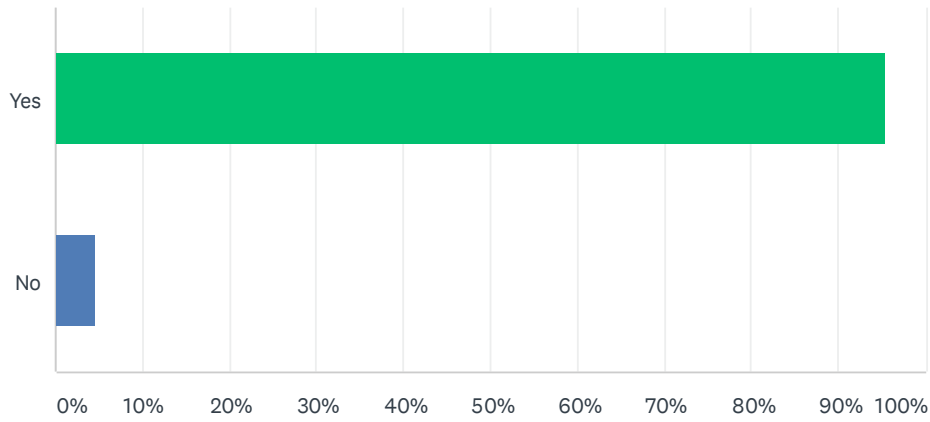

Q2 Are registered to vote?

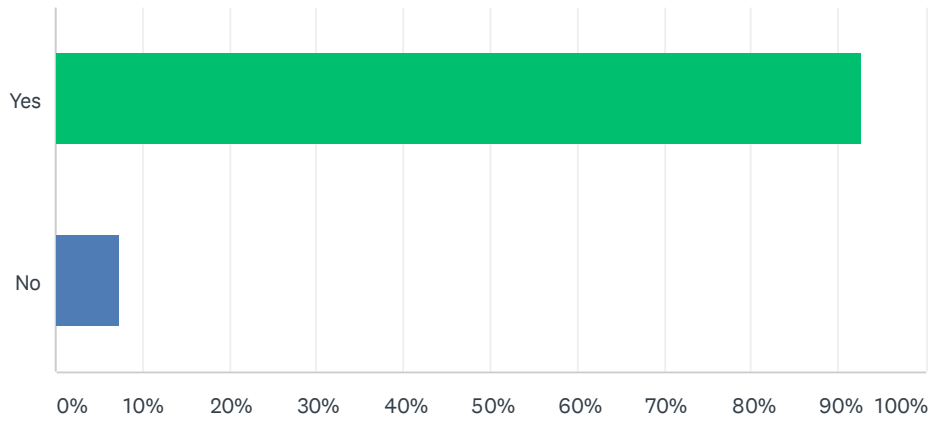

Q3 Do you plan to vote in the upcoming 2020 election?

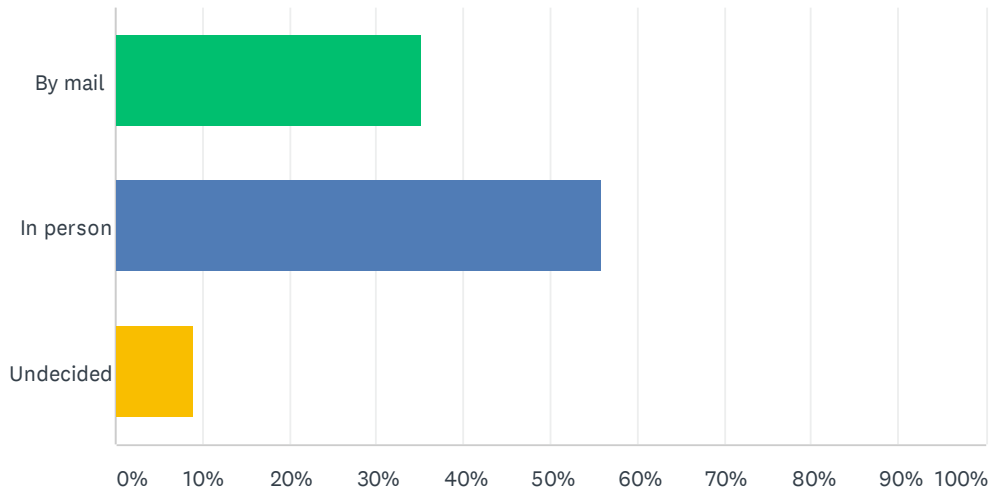

Q4 How do you plan to cast your vote?

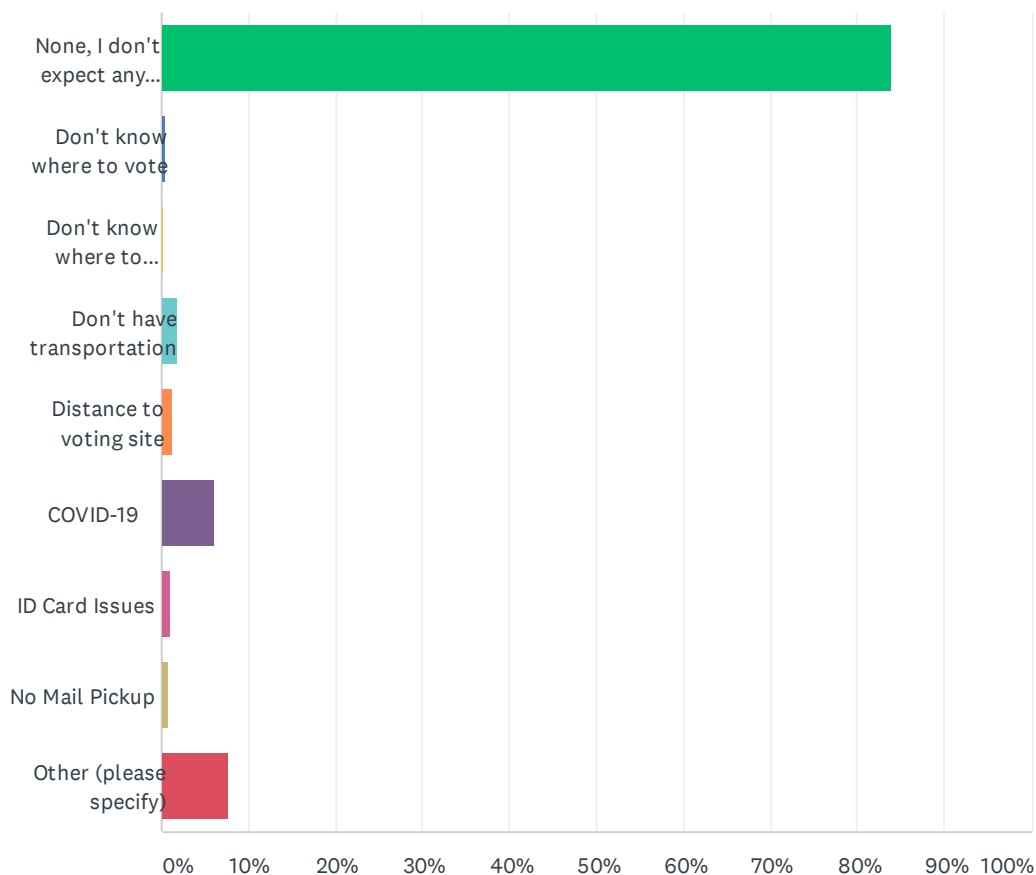

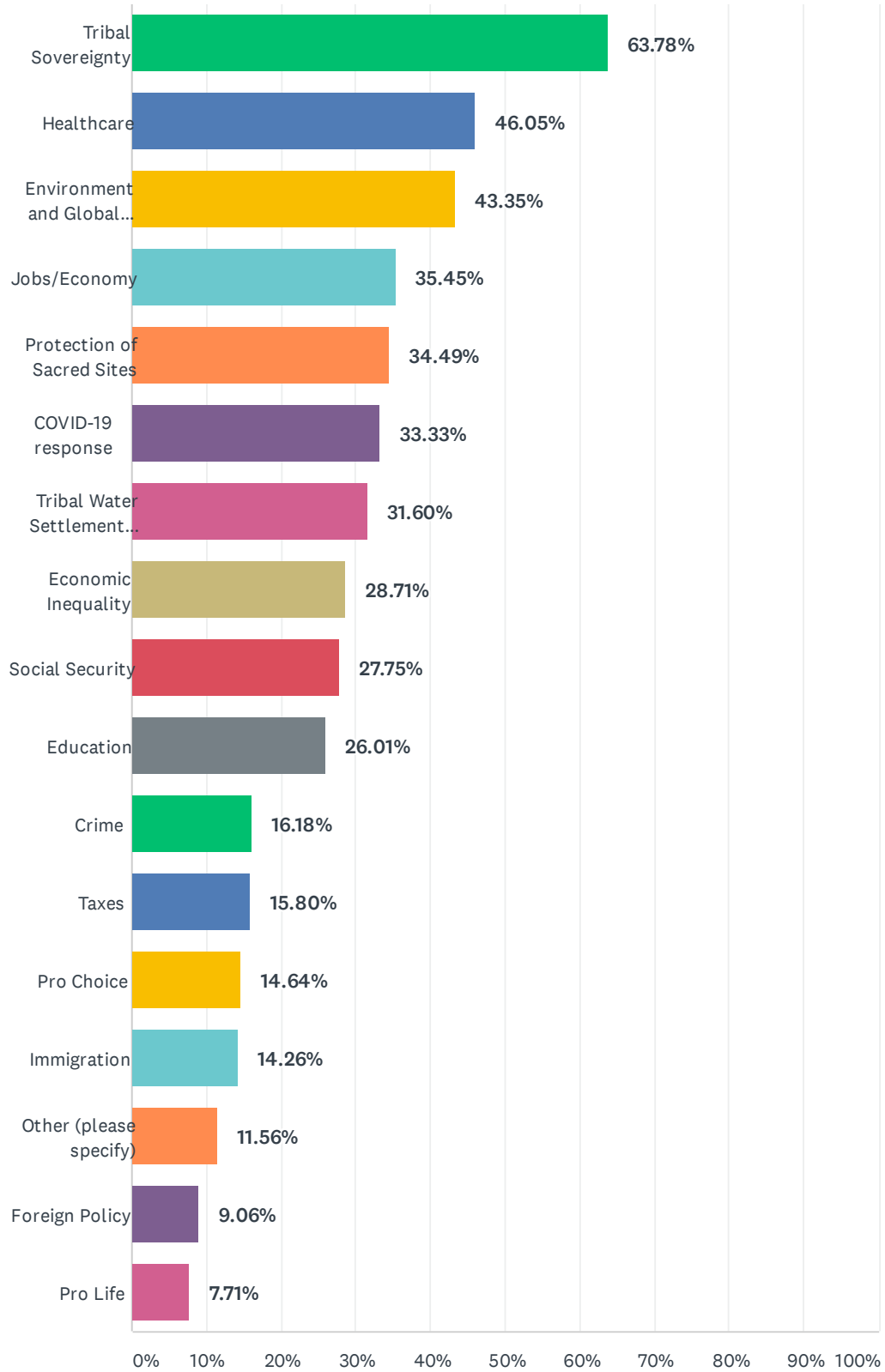

Q6 What issues are most important to you as a voter? (choose your top three)

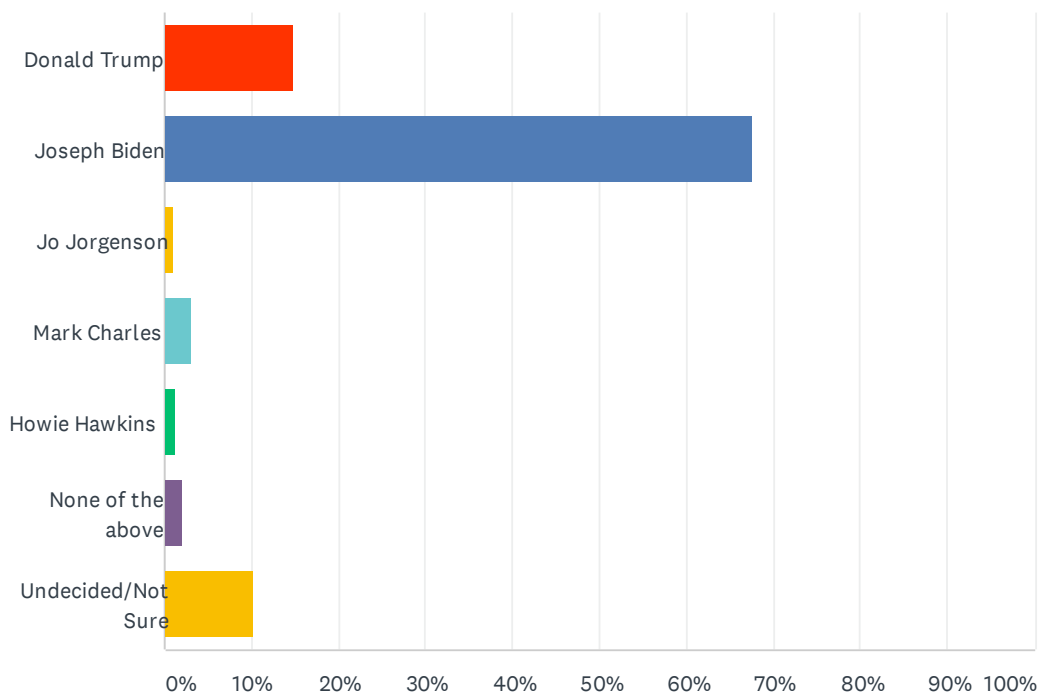

Q7 What candidate are you most likely to support for President in the 2020 election?

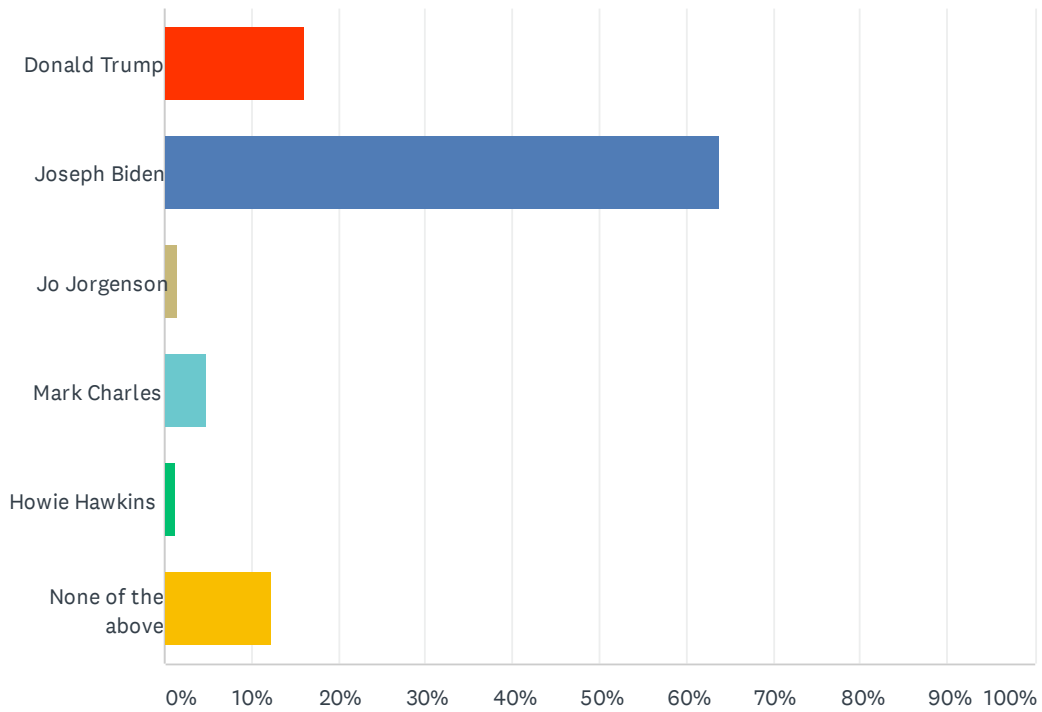

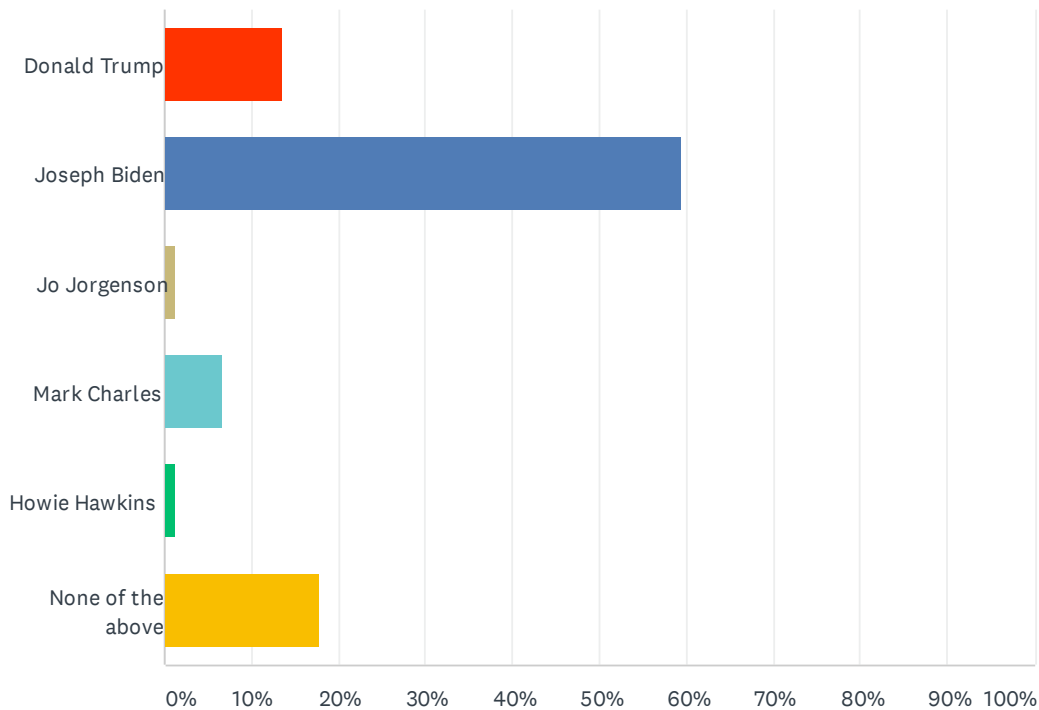

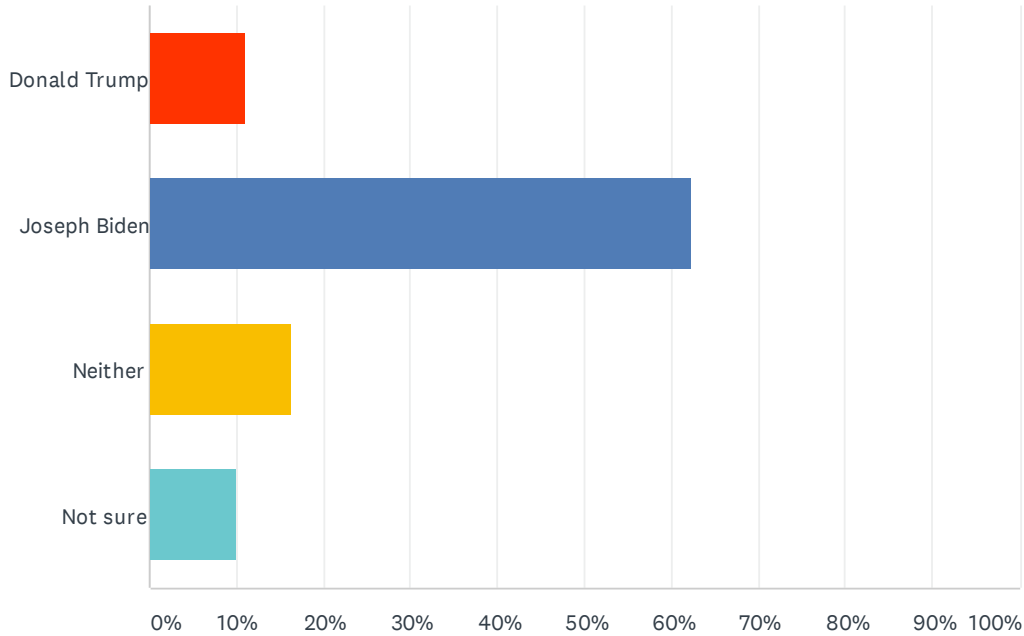

Q10 Thinking about the candidates of the two major political parties, who will do the best at taking care of issues that are important in Indian Country?

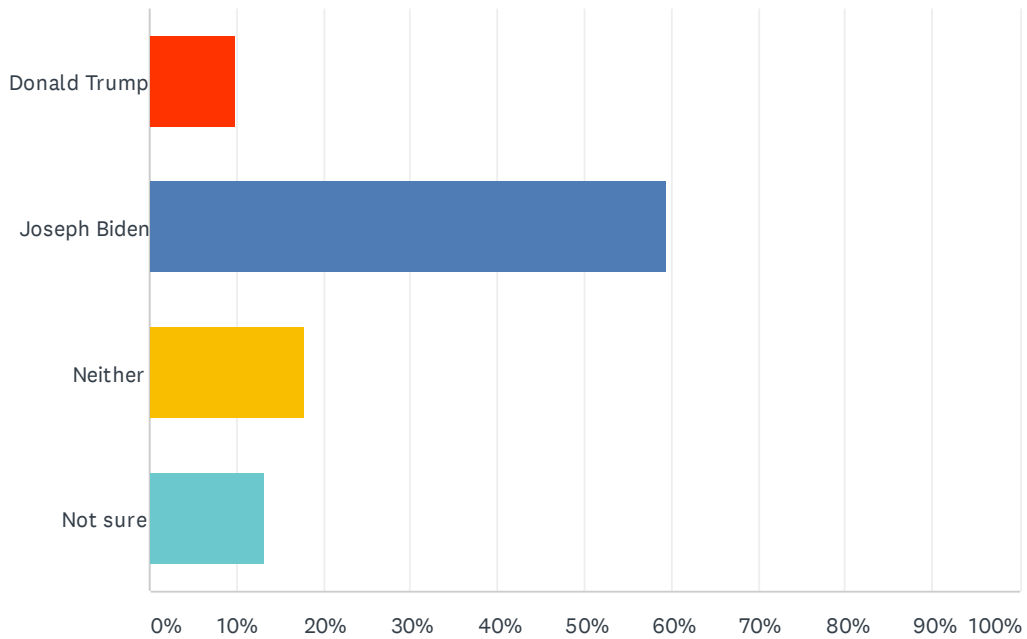

Q11 Of the two major parties candidates, who cares more about Indian Country?

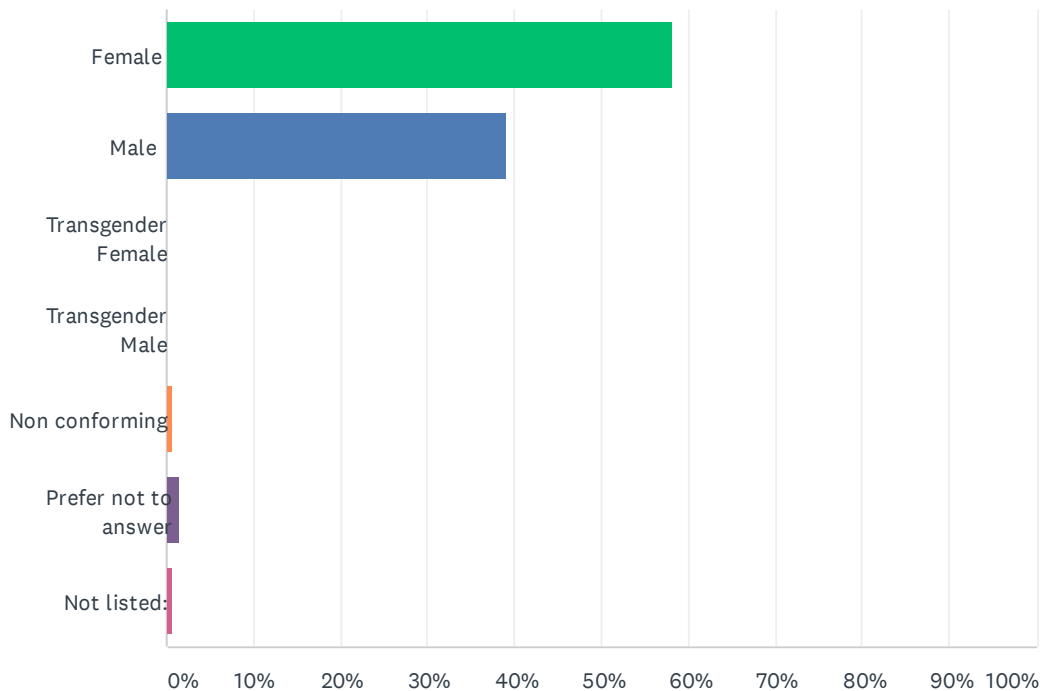

Q12 How do you identify your gender?

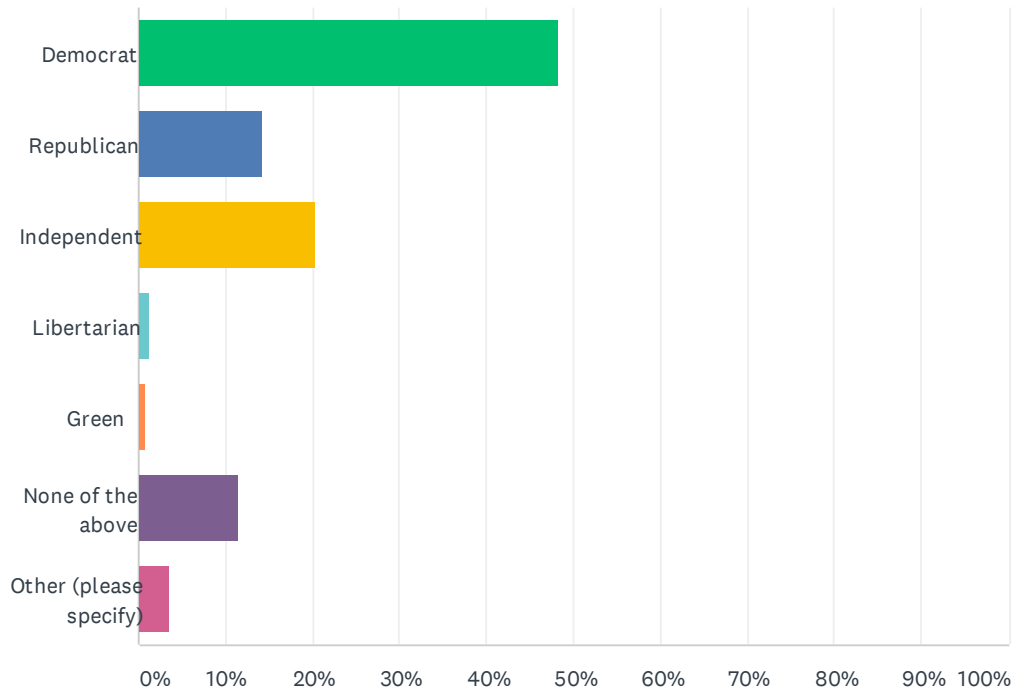

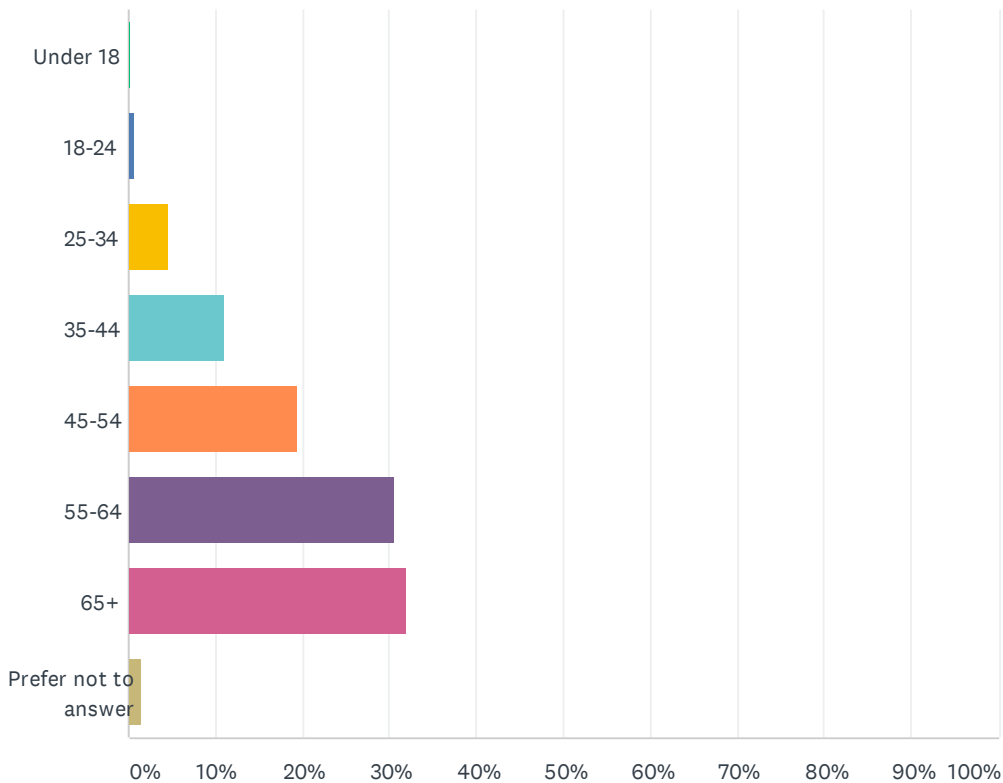

Q14 What age range do you fall between?

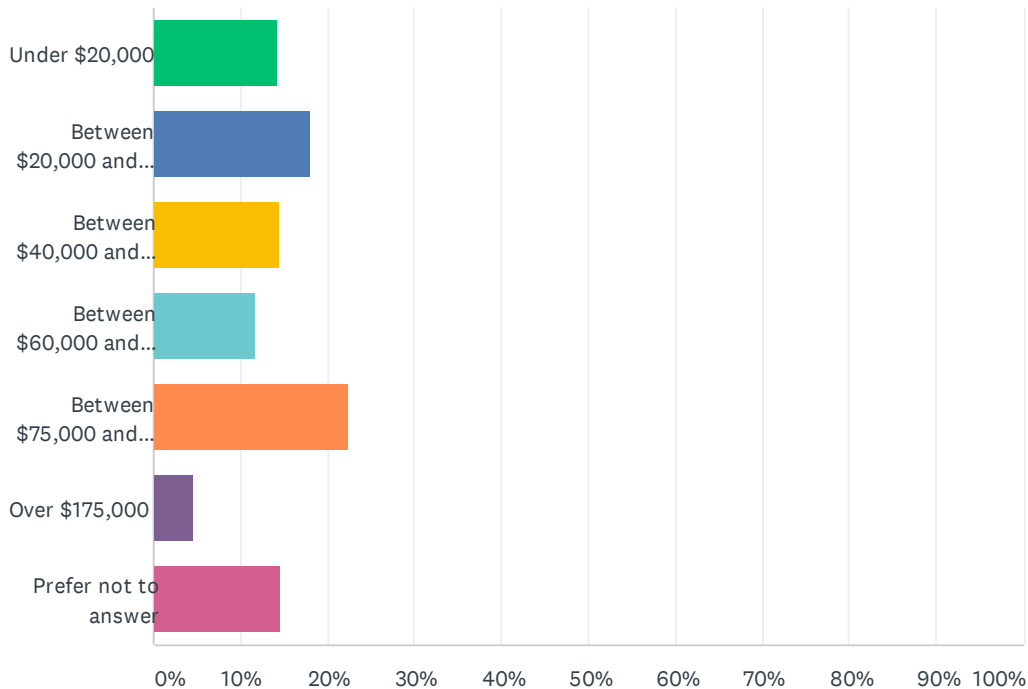

Q15 What is your annual income range?

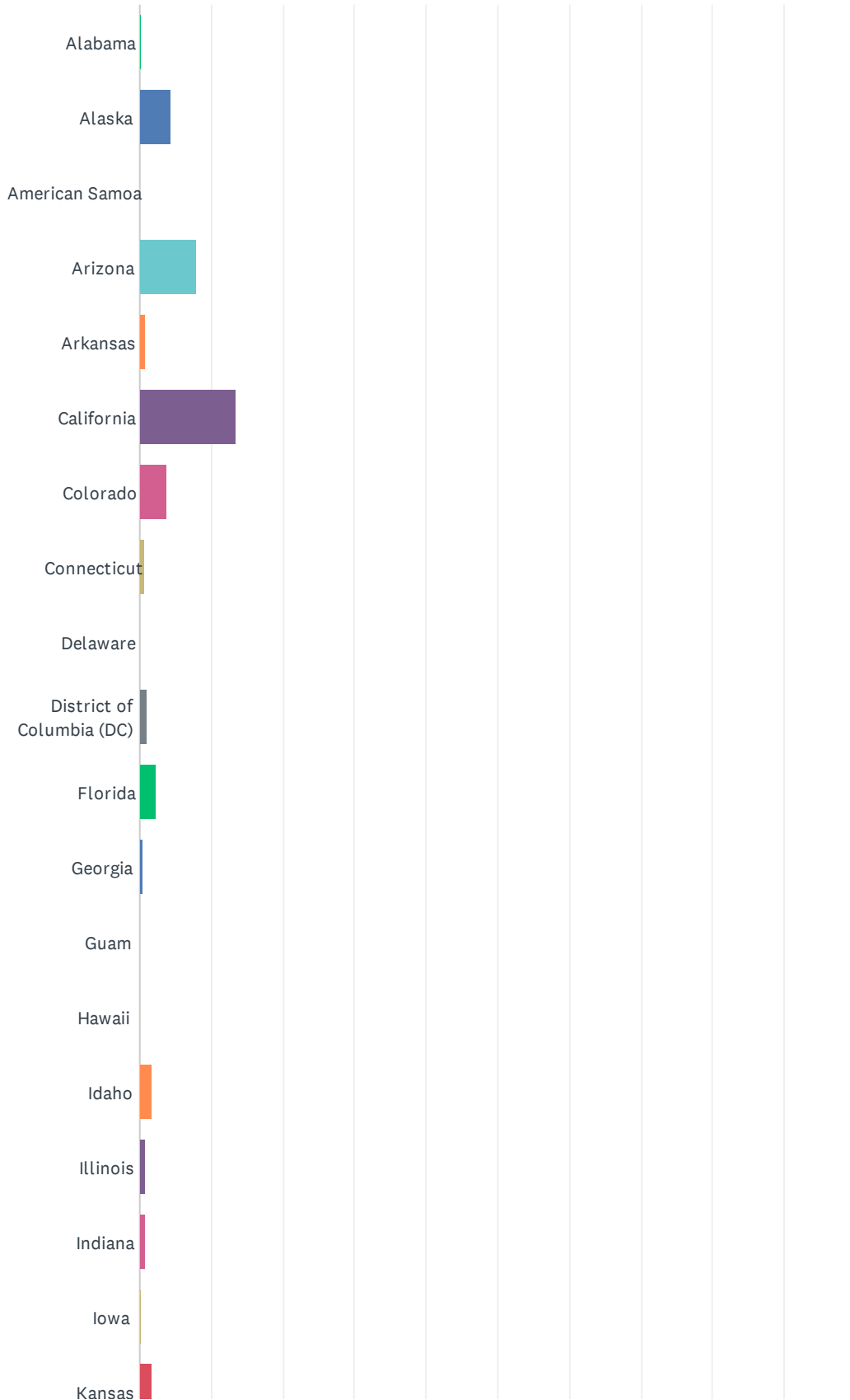

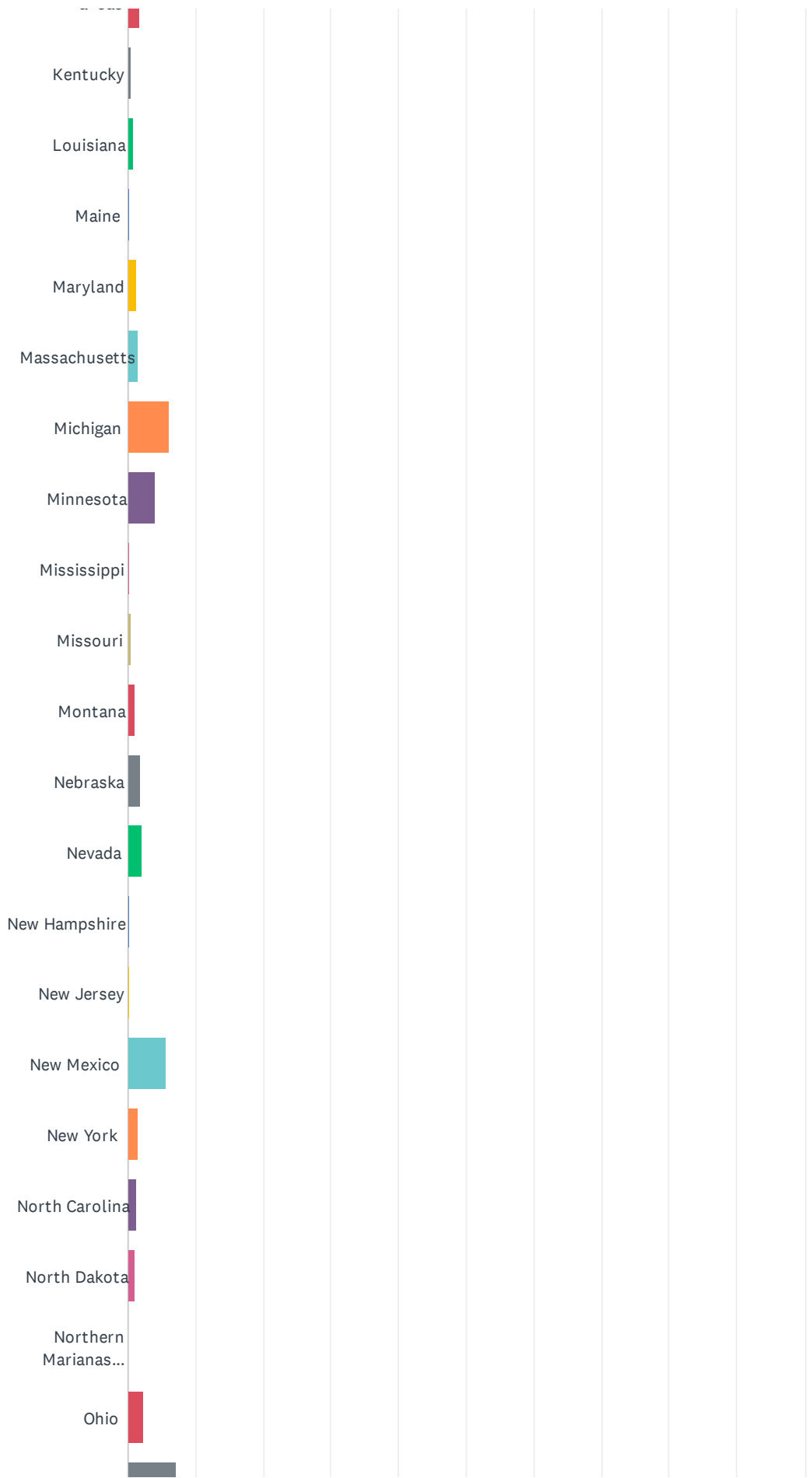

Q16 In what state or U.S. territory do you live?

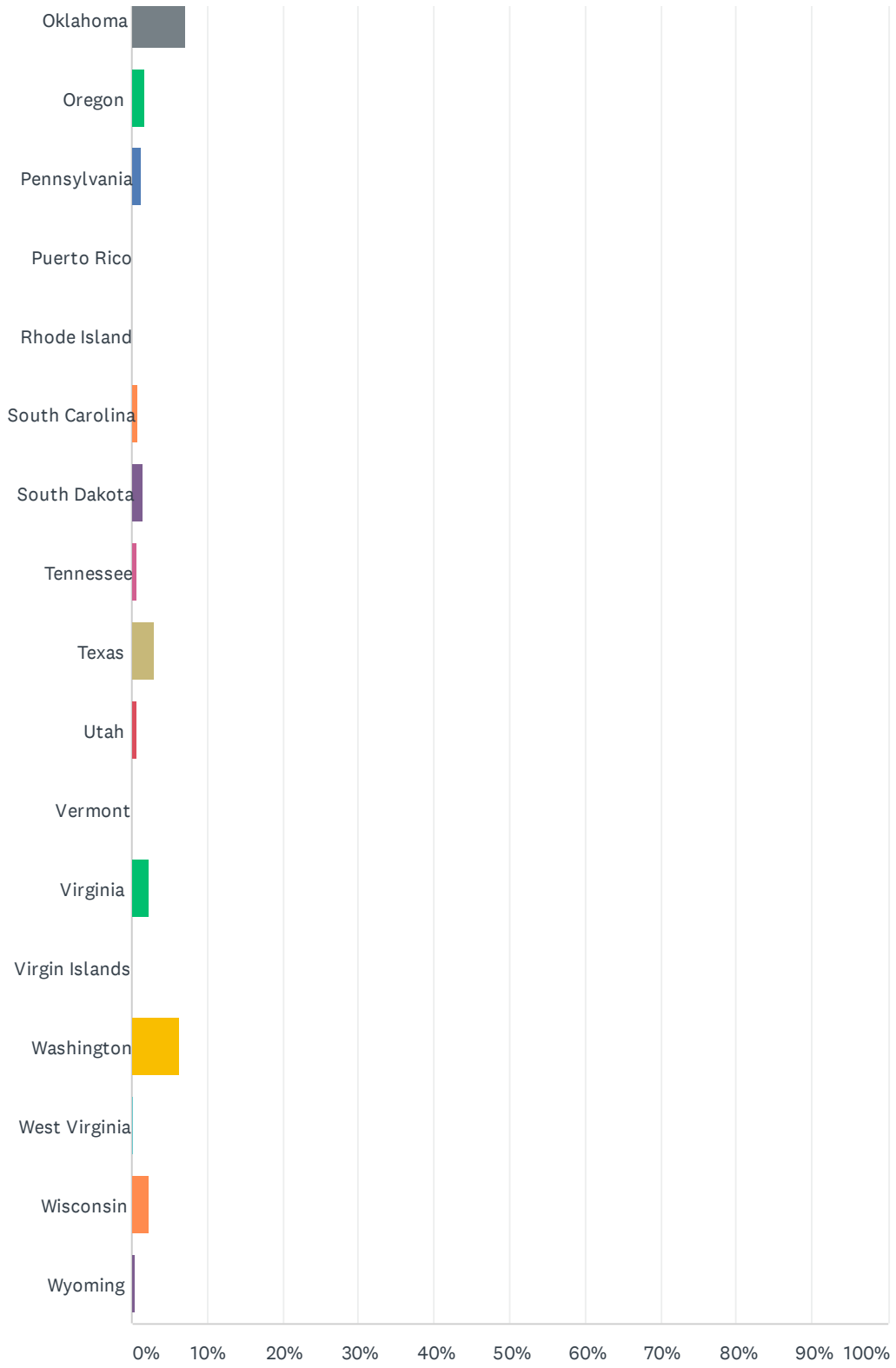
